F. Proposal Submittal Procedures

Sealed proposals shall be submitted as per the schedule set forth in Section I.B of this RFP to the offices of MIRA, 200 Corporate Place, Suite 202, Rocky Hill, Connecticut 06067, Attn: Roger Guzowski. MIRA reserves the right to reject any proposals received after the time and date set forth above.

Each Proposer must submit one (1) “wet ink” original of its proposal and one electronic copy.

The “wet ink” original must contain all original signatures and shall be delivered to MIRA in a sealed envelope that shall be clearly marked “PROPOSAL FOR TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL OF PRE-COMBUSTION FERROUS-SOLID WASTE MIX” The original proposal shall be stamped or otherwise marked as such.

The electronic copy must be in PDF format and submitted to MIRA prior to the due date specified in Section 1B of the RFP, either by: i) ~~be emailed~~ emailing the PDF copy of the proposal to wpfmetals@ctmira.org prior to the due date specified in Section 1B of the RFP, or ii) saving the PDF electronic copy of the proposal to a properly-formatted compact disk (“CD”) or USB flash drive (“Thumb Drive”) and including that CD or Thumb Drive with the printed wet-ink original copy of the proposal that Proposer delivers to MIRA.

Unless otherwise identified by Proposer pursuant to Section I.E.6 hereof, the terms and conditions of the Agreement are non-negotiable. MIRA will review and consider any Business Exceptions taken by Proposer as part of its proposal evaluations.
