As you may be aware, the Materials Innovation and Recycling Authority (MIRA) has submitted an application to the Department of Energy & Environmental Protection to modify its solid waste permit-to-operate for the CSWS Resource Recovery Facility located in Hartford. The permit modification, if approved, would allow MIRA to transfer municipal solid waste on a full-time basis when MIRA suspends operation of its municipal waste combustion activities, which is anticipated to occur on or about June 30, 2022.
