

ADDENDUM NO. 1 Issued April 4, 2024

This Addendum #1 constitutes the additional information concerning the Site tour specified in Section I.F. of the RFP.

1. SITE TOUR AND EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

If they have not already done so, prospective proposers interested in attending the mandatory site tours on April 8, 2024 - as specified in Section I.F. of the RFP - should submit their contact information and expression of interest in the manner specified in Section I.D. of the RFP.

2. NUMBER OF ATTENDEES FROM EACH FIRM

The MIRA Dissolution Authority (the "Authority") requests that prospective proposers attending the site tour limit themselves to not more than 4 attendees per firm.

3. ARRIVING FOR SITE TOUR

Attendees of each site tour should plan to meet at 300 Maxim Road, Gate 70 (the last gate on the left on the Maxim Road cul-de-sac across from Brainard Airport). In the event that the gate is closed, there is a call box at the gate and Authority staff can remotely open the gate for entry. Once on site, attendees should park their vehicles in the office parking lot, proceed to the Authority's headquarters office (the former Waste Processing Facility Operator offices) and sign in with the front desk. The Authority expects to conduct a brief overview (RFP overview, safety overview, etc.) in the headquarters conference room before proceeding to view the with the tour of the site.

4. SITE TOUR PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Listed below are the minimum requirements for touring the areas containing Inoperable Heavy Equipment and Miscellaneous Scrap metal at the Resource Recovery Facility. These requirements must be met or you will be denied access to the facility.

- 1) Long Pants
- 2) Long Sleeve Shirts
- 3) Safety Glass
- 4) Leather upper hard sole shoes
- 5) Hardhat
- 6) Safety Vest

5. SITE TOUR LIGHTING

Some of the scrap material is stored in an indoor area with lighting that will remain turned off during the tour. The Authority will use flashlights during this portion of the tour but does not have flashlights for use by tour attendees. Therefore, the Authority is asking attendees to bring their own flashlights to the tour.
